Screened Reclaimed Soil is a fine material derived from natural waste. It is a dark and rich soil and is an excellent multi-purpose, environmentally friendly product.

- **Use**

It is suitable for use under turf, for raising ground level and for levelling uneven surfaces.

Screened Soil is available for either delivery or collection.

- **Raw Materials**

The raw materials for producing screened soil is predominantly soil disposed of from land excavations and demolition, usually contaminated with brick, wood, metal and plastic.

- **Site Of Manufacture**

All recycling processes are done on our site in Deptford. We offer an open invitation to anyone who would like to visit our site to view any of our operations.

- **Manufacture Process**

The raw materials are passed through various screening plants (large revolving sieves) to separate the soil from the contaminants. The raw material is sieved to produce two products, the clean screened soil, which leaves the plant on the first conveyor belt, and the contaminants, which travel through the plant, are segregated and then recycled as necessary.
